





Steps to a successful project





Partners



Involve a limited number of partners to ensure real collaboration.

Projects more than 10 participants are not recommended

Online meeting

know one another

Involve at least 2-3 partners.

Making sure you have someone to work with.


Avoid numerous projects


Avoid participation at the same time.

Some advice...

Decide with your students the topic they would like to work on If it is a European project, the two founders should come from different countries

Inform the students and parents and make sure you have the parental consents Agree and share a work plan and time the different schedule with all your activities/approaches partners with your students





Students' participation

Update their TwinSpace profiles

Choose a picture that represents them (sports, music, avatar) and not their own picture

> Leave short messages on their partners' walls


Log in regularly


Start interacting with their partners



Netiquette

Netiquette is the use of courtesy and respect in the online environment





Plan live sessions that establish a culture of communication Give students questions to consider/prepare before the session

Other activities

Prepare short collaborative activities (games, quizzes) or plan a less structured event.

Assessment

Set SMART objectives and evaluate how they have been reached Use simple polls and surveys to get feedback from the participants of the project

Ask students to reflect on their learning experiences and don't forget transversal skills such as learning to learn, collaboration, and leadership.

Add the results of your surveys/polls in the TwinSpace as clear evidence.
