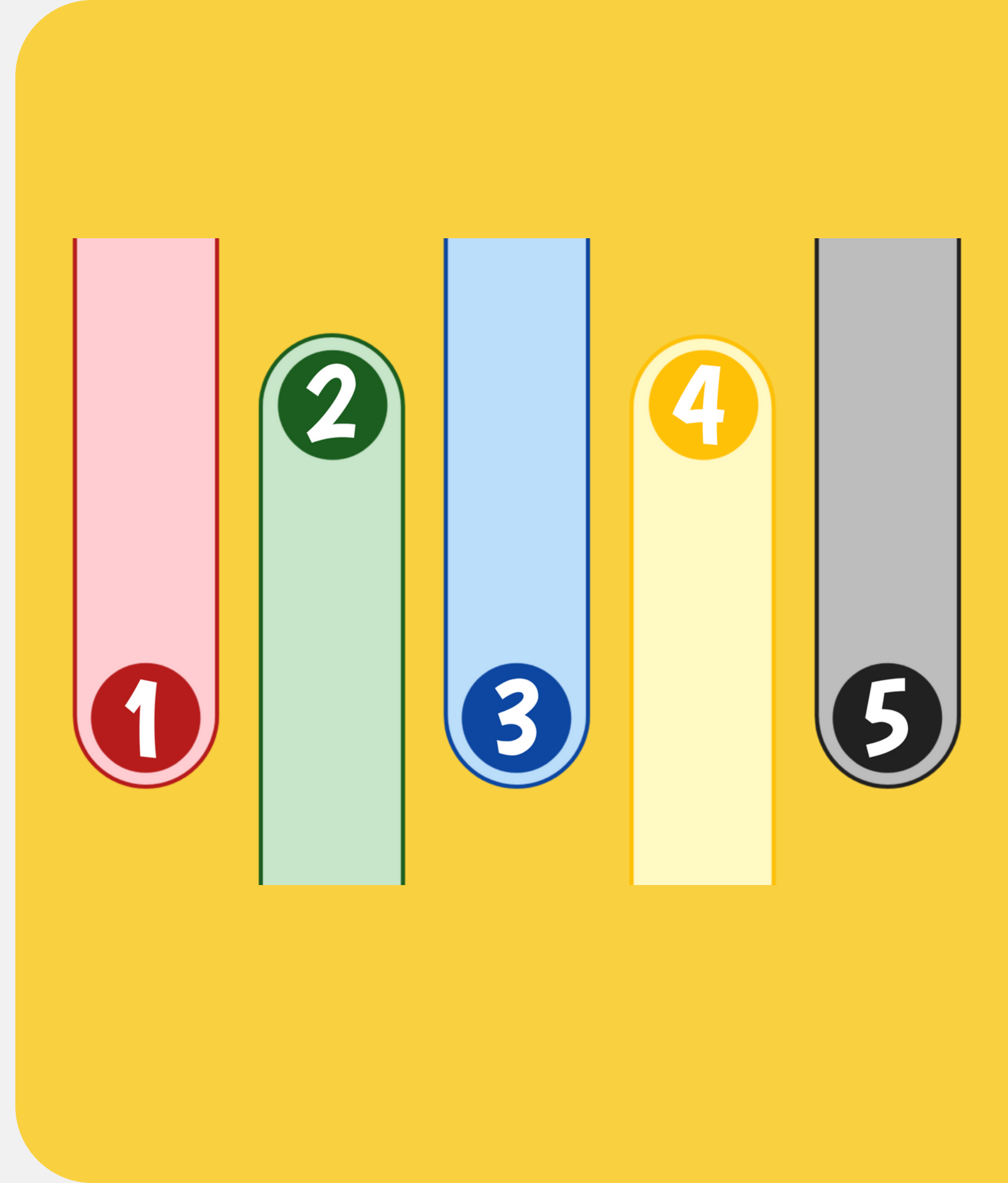




How to plan a quality collaborative project

Steps to a successful project



Partners



Involve a limited number of partners to ensure real collaboration.

Projects more than 10 participants are not recommended

Online meeting

know one another

Involve at least 2-3 partners.

Making sure you have someone to work with.

Avoid numerous projects

Avoid participation at the same time.

Some advice...

- ★ Decide with your students the topic they would like to work on
- ★ If it is a European project, the two founders should come from different countries
- ★ Decide with your students the topic they would like to work on
- ★ Inform the students and parents and make sure you have the parental consents
- ★ Agree and share a work plan and time schedule with all your partners
- ★ Brainstorm and discuss the different activities/approaches with your students

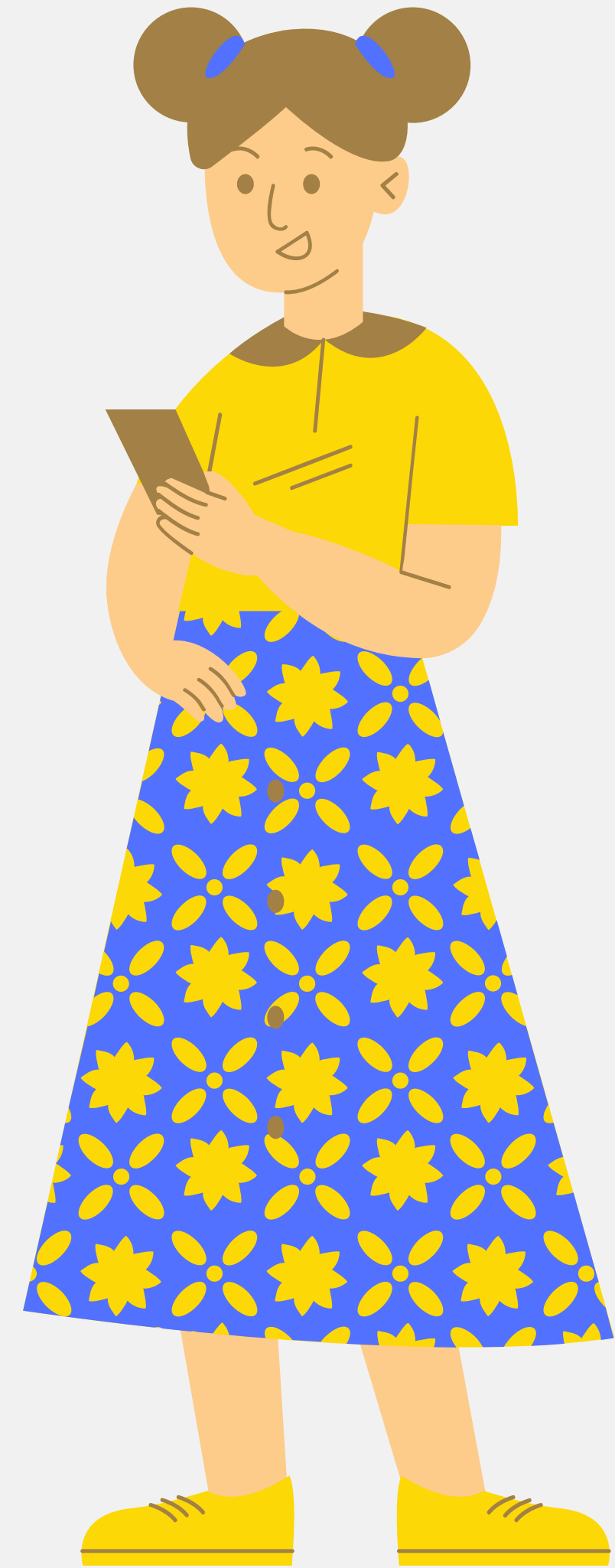
Update their

not their own picture

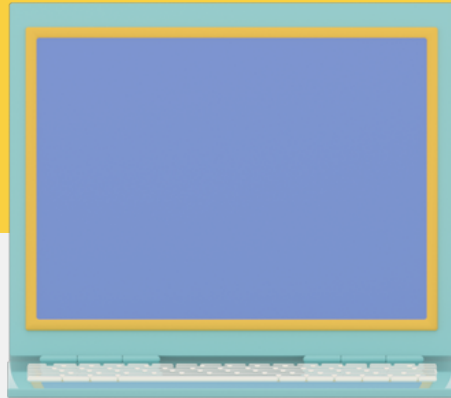
Start interacting

Other activities



Plan live sessions that establish a culture of communication



Give students questions to consider/prepare before the session



Prepare short collaborative activities (games, quizzes) or plan a less structured event.

Assessment

Set SMART objectives and evaluate how they have been reached

Use simple polls and surveys to get feedback from the participants of the project

Add the results of your surveys/polls in the TwinSpace as clear evidence.



Ask students to reflect on their learning experiences and don't forget transversal skills such as learning to learn, collaboration, and leadership.
